GENERAL PERSONNEL – Section 504 or ADA Grievance Procedure

The Regional Office of Education has adopted an internal grievance procedure providing for prompt and equitable resolution of complaints alleging any action prohibited by regulations implementing Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended (29 U.S.C. 794) or the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Section 504 states, in part, that “no otherwise qualified disabled individual . . . will , solely by reason of his disability, be excluded from the participation, be denied the benefits, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance”
