GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

Students are a major concern of the Regional Office of Education. All policies and actions of the Regional Office of Education and of the staff should be directed toward promoting the educational welfare of the students in the Regional Office of Education programs. 3. To enhance the self-image of each student by helping him/her to feel respected and worthy, and creating a school environment that provides positive encouragement through frequent success.
4. To provide the opportunity for students learn personal and civic responsibility for their actions through meaningful experiences as school citizens.
5. To deal with students in matters of discipline in a just and constructive manner.
6. To provide for the safety, health, and welfare of students.
