ATTENDANCE – Pregnant Students

The Regional Office of Education affirms the right of a pregnant student to continue her participation in the public school program.

The expectant mother may be excused from school when, in her doctor's opinion her physical and/or emotional well-being warrants that such measures be taken. In such instances, the ROE or home school shall provide for instruction during her period of absence from school.

The rights of a pregnant student do not exclude her responsibility for observing the student rules and regulations established by the ROE and do not exempt her from disciplinary measures imposed for breaking ROE rules.
