RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES – Electronic Signaling Devices and Laser Pointers

The personal use or possession of electronic signaling devices, i.e., pagers, laser pointers and cellular telephones, by students shall be prohibited on the school premises. The administration or designee shall confiscate all electronic signaling devices found on the school campus. The presence of such a device may be cause for further search for possession of drugs and appropriate discipline as established by the Regional Office of Education policies.

The Regional Office of Education considers possession of signaling devices or facsimiles of same an act that interrupts the educational process, endangers the well-being of students and staff, and is an unauthorized activity on any school premises or at any school function.

Unauthorized signaling devices shall be confiscated, and the possessor may be subject to Regional Office of Education disciplinary action.
