DISCIPLINE – Use of Behavioral Interventions for a Student Receiving Special Education Services

The home school district will comply with the ISBE “Behavioral Interventions in Schools” guidelines and shall ensure, for identified students receiving special education, that the selected behavioral interventions are carried out as prescribed in the behavioral management plan and are part of the student’s IEP.

A behavior management plan (BMP) shall be written for students who receive special education services and also exhibit serious behavioral problems. The behavior management plans (BMPs) shall be based on a functional analysis of the student’s behavior and shall describe the interventions to be used, the methods of evaluation, and provision for coordination with the family.

The home district’s policies will apply once the student has been suspended.
