STUDENT RECORDS – Student Record Challenges

The parents/guardians or eligible students may challenge the accuracy, relevancy or propriety of the records, except grades, and request a hearing. The Regional Office of Education’s policy on filing complaints should be followed by those wishing to challenge student records.

Parents/guardians may insert in their child’s school record a statement of reasonable length stating their position on any disputed information contained in that record. The school will include a copy of the statement in any release of the information in dispute.

The release of confidential information given by a student to a therapist (e.g., school social worker or psychologist) is not included in this policy but is governed by the Mental Health and Development Disabilities Confidentiality Act.
