

ROE – COMMUNITY RELATIONS

VISITORS TO THE ROE – Conduct on ROE Property

To maintain safety and appropriate conduct while on Regional Office of Education property, the Regional Superintendent or his/her designee shall have the right to limit and/or ban individuals from ROE property or activities.

If decorum and safety are to be maintained, individuals who harass, threaten or constantly display inappropriate behavior toward ROE staff may be restricted from entry onto ROE property.

The initial restriction may be limiting entry onto ROE property and/or activities to schedule appointments and public events. Continued inappropriate conduct or an extremely aggressive initial incident may result in a total ban from ROE property.

Failure to follow the limited or total ban notice may result in arrest for criminal trespass in accordance with the provisions of the Criminal Code of the State of Illinois.
