

ROE – COMMUNITY RELATIONS

PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS IN THE ROE

It is the Regional Office of Education’s intention to safeguard the students, their parents, and staff of the ROE from money raising plans of outside organizations, commercial enterprises and individuals; from materials supporting or rejecting political candidates or issues; and from materials promoting religious issues.

Materials of an educational nature from commercial enterprises and individuals may be accepted in limited quantities for distribution through the offices of the ROE. A copy of approved materials will be posted with the indication that additional information is available in the office.

This policy applies particularly to ticket sales and sales of articles or services except those directly sponsored or handled by the ROE authorities. Outside organizations shall not be permitted to advertise events through the ROE or use the students to sell tickets except those jointly ROE-sponsored or ROE-approved parent-teacher activities.

All information, advertising, tickets, and other materials must carry the name of the sponsor. Materials or equipment, which carries advertising copy that has an inherent educational value, may be accepted for distribution to students.

The Regional Superintendent shall develop, or cause to be developed, guidelines for distribution of materials, information, etc., through the ROE.
